## Monica Tesler - Author Visits, 2017-2018 School Year

Here are some key considerations about my school visits:

- I am available for a maximum of four, fifty-minute workshop presentations per day plus one kick-off assembly presentation. Workshops typically consist of 1-2 classes at a time.
- Summaries of my presentations are below. Additional topics may be available, and presentations typically can be custom modified. Although my presentations are generally geared toward students in grades 4-8, I can tailor to an older or younger audience upon request.
- All workshops are tied to Common Core State Standards. Some workshops are also tied to Next Generation Science Standards.
- I can provide you with information for book orders in advance of my visit. You can work with a local bookstore partner, coordinate an order with a bookstore I suggest, or place a bulk order through Simon & Schuster.
- The best author visits start with prepared students. If at all possible, ask students to read my books prior to my visit and discuss in advance.
- BOUNDERS can easily be incorporated into the curriculum. Simon & Schuster has created an excellent discussion guide as well as a STEM curriculum companion for the first book in the series, both free downloadable assets for educators.
- I include a technology component in most workshop presentations. The
  presentations are in Power Point. I will bring a thumb drive that can be used with
  the classroom computer. I will also have my MacAir and a VGA Adaptor as a
  back-up. The classroom and/or auditorium should be equipped with a ready-to-go
  Smartboard or projector and screen.

## MONICA TESLER, SCHOOL PRESENTATIONS

With sufficient notice, the workshops and presentations described below can be custom tailored for your school. Workshops begin with a brief introduction about me, BOUNDERS, and publishing in general, and then shift into a topical focus.

- Prime then Polish: Revision Tips & Tricks Workshop: Using BOUNDERS as a model, I give students a window into the revision and editing process that goes into creating a traditionally published book. Then we will roll up our sleeves and focus on real revision techniques they can bring to their own writing. (Approximately 50 minutes) Common Core Alignment: W.4.5, W.5.5, W.6.5, W.7.5, W.8.5
- Science and Science Fiction Workshop: Real Life Science as Story Inspiration: Many of the ideas in BOUNDERS and its sequels come from real life, cutting edge science. With a focus on science, we discuss how the real world inspires and provides a foundation for fiction and vice versa. (Approximately 50 minutes) Common Core Alignment: W.4.3, W.5.3, W.6.3, W.7.3, W.8.3 Next Generation Science Standards: Can be modified to align with multiple NGSS standards.
- <u>My Two Super Powers: Imagination & Perseverance</u>: This presentation is best suited for an all-school or all-grade assembly, often to kick off reading month, summer reading, or another initiative, and typically paired with one or more workshops described above. (Approximately 15 minutes)
